1. LEGAL INFORMATION AND ACCEPTANCE

By virtue of compliance with Law 34/2002, of the 11th of July, on Information Society and Electronic Trade Services (hereinafter LISETS), we would like to inform you that INTERPROFESIONAL AGROALIMENTARIA DEL PORCINO DE CAPA BLANCA (hereinafter, INTERPORC), with registered address in Madrid, at Calle Fortuny, nº 37, 1ª Planta, Post code: 28010, with Fiscal Identification Code G85661577, and email address lopd@interporc.es, is at Internet Users' disposal through the domain www.interporc.com (hereinafter, "the Web Site"). INTERPORC is acknowledged as Organización Interprofesional Agroalimentaria del Porcino de Capa Blanca by the Ministry of Agriculture, Food and the Environment and in the OSG No. 201 of the 21st of August, 2008, Order ARM/2472/2008, of the 1st of August. The service provided by INTERPORC through the Web Site (hereinafter, the "Service") consists of placing at users' disposal graphic and audiovisual material relative to animal wellbeing in the porcine sector.
